

INMATE DRUG SCREENING

PURPOSE: To update the AR to correspond to the implementation of the revised

Classification System and Classification Manual in July 2009.

CHANGES TO BE MADE:

AR 440, *Inmate Drug Screening*, January 25, 2007.

Section V. B. 2. Change sentence to read "Inmates assigned to a Community Based

Institution will be tested at a greater frequency that those assigned

to a major institution."

Section V. E. 4. c). Change sentence to read "Complete and submit an ADOC Form

302-A Incident Report, anytime a urine specimen is declined and

not tested."

Section V. G. 8. Change sentence to read "Minimum-Community custody inmates

who test positive for drug use (other than alcohol or marijuana) will be returned to a major institution on the first offense for

reclassification."

Section V. H. 6. Change sentence to read "Minimum-Community custody inmates

who test positive for alcohol or marijuana after having completed a substance abuse program may be entered into a Relapse Prevention

program."

Section V. I. 3. Change sentence to read "The one-step testing device (test sticks and multiple panels) used by Community Based Institutions will be ordered and distributed through the Director of Treatment."

File this numbered change at the back of the regulation after annotating both the index and the regulation to indicate changes have been completed. Advise all personnel in your organization of the change to this regulation.
