7. Will the awarded contractor be required to sign a lease for the property located within the fence?	Yes.
8. Who is the current lab being used for sampling?	Southern Environmental Testing.
9. There is a large sum of trash accumulated in the lagoon. Who will be responsible for cleaning this out? Both Labor and Cost.	Vendor.
10. Will the ADOC maintain responsibility of Dredging the Lagoons when appropriate?	Yes.
11. Would the ADOC consider paying for High Tide SCADA unit to attached to the Head Works which would notify operators of power outages?	Vendor will be responsible.
